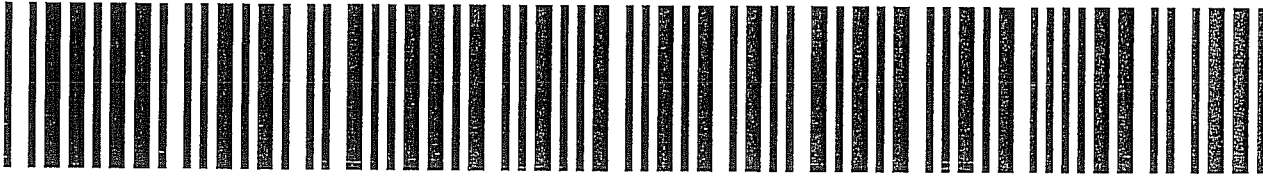

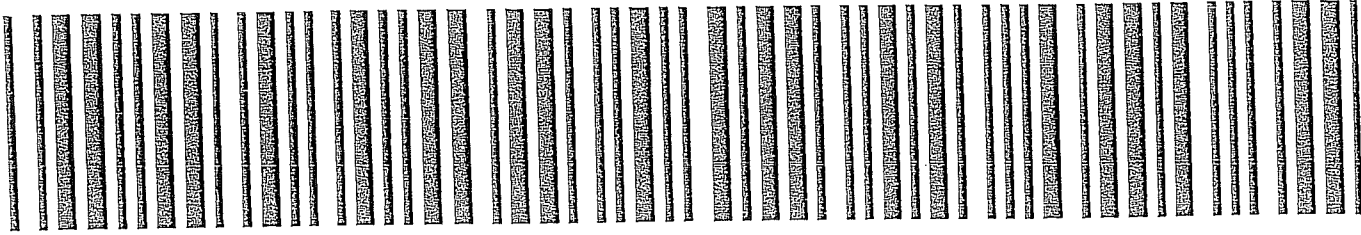

15 Applicant is submitting this motion in order to defend herself from the
16 ongoing tactics of the defendants. Defendants continue filing frivolous and
17 unnecessary subpoena's in order to obtain private and confidential E-Mail
18 material. This Honorable Court should construe this entire pleading as submitted
19 under the penalties of perjury. The applicant attests that such statements are
20 truthful and factual and not submitted for the purposes of harassment or delay.
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1 It appears that Defendants are in violation of

2 **California Labor Code Section 4055.2**

3 *Any party who subpoenas records in any proceeding under*
4 *this division shall concurrent with service of the subpoena upon the*
5 *person who has possession of the records, send a copy of the subpoena*
6 *to all parties of record in the proceeding.*

7 Applicant was never informed about this pending Subpoena. Had Google
8 Inc. not notified the Applicant, she would have never known about this frivolous
9 action. Applicant is now concerned that other subpoena's may have been sent out.

11 **California Labor Code Section 3702**

12 *(3) Intentionally refusing to comply with known and legally*
13 *indisputable compensation obligations.*

15 Defendants should not be allowed to continue harassing the Applicant and
16 continue to cause unnecessary emotional distress on the Applicant. Applicant is
17 trying to get the necessary treatment to cure and relieve her of the injuries, and
18 believes she does not need this constant barrage of frivolous tactics. These tactics
19 of trying to subpoena private and confidential e mails have no relevance at all in
20 the fact that the Applicant suffered an undisputed Industrial injury dating to 1994
21 and Applicant has an already established Award and Order from over a decade
22 ago. Applicant believes these continuous tactics are solely intended to further delay

1 proceedings and deny treatment.

14 have GOOGLE INC release such information.

15 Defendants are intentionally trying to involve a third party who unknowingly will
16 be assisting the defendants to violate HIPPA.

17 Applicant is asking this tribunal to quash the subpoena filed by the Defendants on
18 GOOGLE INC. Applicant is requesting that the Defendants obtain a pre filing
19 order from this tribunal before issuing any more subpoenas and before filing any
20 more frivolous and unnecessary pleadings.



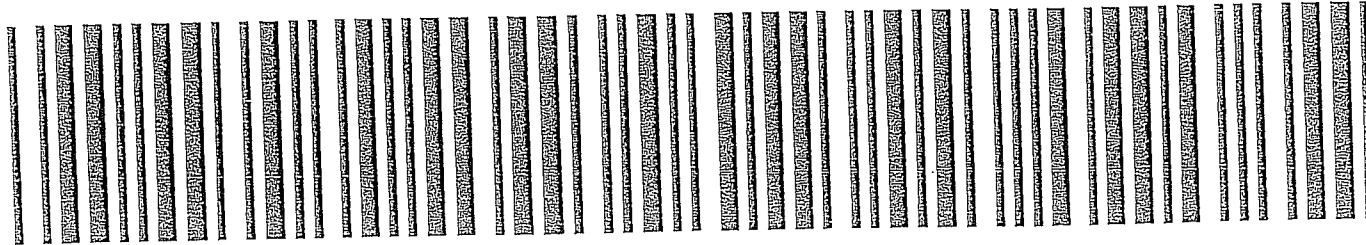

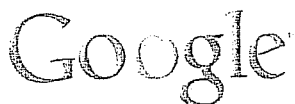

Dear Barbara Clark:

We have received your subpoena for documents, dated 01-24-2011, in the above-referenced matter. As we understand it, you are seeking documents related to the Gmail account FLYFISH4EVER.

This letter is to advise you that Google has forwarded notice of this matter, including your name and contact information, to the user at the email address provided by the user.

Section 2702(a) of the federal Electronic Communications Privacy Act prohibits Google from disclosing the content of electronic communications pursuant to a civil subpoena. 18 U.S.C. § 2702(a); *Theofel v. Farey-Jones*, 359 F.3d 1066 (9th Cir. 2004); see also *In re Subpoena Duces Tecum to AOL, LLC.*, 550 F.Supp.2d 606, 611 (E.D. Va. 2008); *Flagg v. City of Detroit*, 252 F.R.D. 346, 366 (E.D. Mich. 2008); *Viacom Int'l Inc. v. YouTube Inc.*, 253 F.R.D. 256 (S.D.N.Y. 2008); *O'Grady v. Superior Court of Santa Clara*, 139 Cal. App. 4th 1423, 1441-43 (2006). The appropriate way to seek such content is to direct your request to the account holder who has custody and control of the data in the account. *O'Grady*, 139 Cal. App. 4th at 1446-47.

Furthermore, if the account holder is a party to the underlying litigation, you may serve a document request on the account holder for the content sought. See *id.*; see also *Flagg*, 252 F.R.D. at 348, 366-67.

Pursuant to Rule 45 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and all analogous rules under any applicable state law, Google Inc. ("Google"), which is not a party to the underlying action, responds and objects to the subpoena for deposition testimony for at least the following reasons.

1. Google objects to the subpoena to appear for a deposition on the grounds that it imposes an undue burden on Google, a non-party, to appear as a witness. Google also objects to the subpoena to appear for a deposition on the grounds that the information sought can be obtained through less burdensome means, including from the parties to the case.
2. Google objects to the subpoena to appear for a deposition on the grounds it is vague, overbroad, duplicative, cumulative, unduly burdensome, and oppressive. Google objects to the subpoena to appear for a deposition to the extent that the subpoena is

abusively drawn and served for the purpose of annoying and harassing Google, a non-party.

Google requests the opportunity to meet and confer to determine the scope and applicability of the above objections.

Google objects to the requests in the subpoena to the extent they seek information already in Claimant's possession or available to Claimant from some other source that is more convenient, less burdensome or less expensive, including information available to Claimant from public sources. This means that if you are seeking account or other information from Google that is equally available from a party in the litigation, Google objects to that request on that basis. Google also objects to the requests to the extent they seek information containing confidential financial, proprietary or trade secret information, or any information subject to a confidentiality agreement or protective order. While Google does not require a protective order for production of its non-confidential information, Google will only produce information it deems confidential pursuant to a confidentiality agreement or protective order that it deems suitable for the protection of its confidential information. Please provide a confidentiality agreement or protective order if you intend to seek confidential documents of Google in your requests, as we will not produce confidential information without entry of a protective order that we deem suitable to protect the confidentiality of our documents.

Google further objects to the requests to the extent they seek information protected by any privilege, including the attorney-client privilege, work product immunity doctrine, common interest privilege, or any other applicable privilege, immunity, or restriction on discovery. We also object to the requests to the extent that they are irrelevant, overly broad, vague, ambiguous, unlimited in time or scope, fail to identify the information sought with reasonable particularity, or impose an undue burden on Google. Google objects to the requests to the extent that they seek information that is not relevant or reasonably likely to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence.

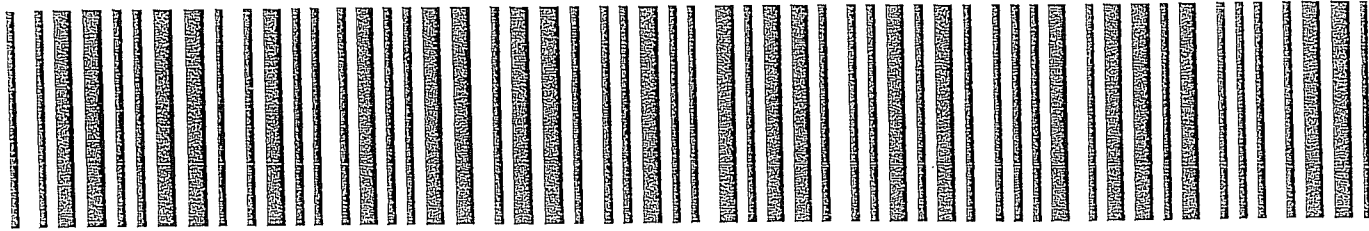

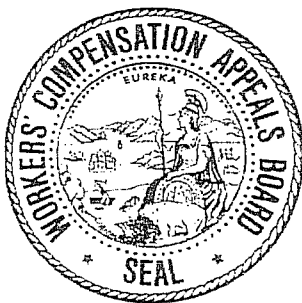
