REF: Pre-litigation spoliation letter, duty to preserve

Dear Sir,

I call attention to a sixty (60) second video made by President George W. Bush on behalf of the hospital system run by the Adventology group in Placer County. This video is presently displayed on the service known as "You Tube", or Internet address www.YouTube.com. This video, posted by a user named "LONCHITOKL", is a testimonial by the President, dated January 2007, presumably given for preserving the status of the cults' leaders and a political crony of Mr. Bush (see allegations with reference to Congressman John T. Doolittle, Placer County).

I take note that you and Congressman Doolittle are members of the same religious cult. Therefore, in view of the totality of circumstances of the present health care privacy violation investigations, or lack thereof by the U.S. Attorney General, I must assume that you have consulted with Congressman Doolittle about the situation with the Adventology hospital cartel. You may have even thwarted official investigations of your department into this matter, based upon your religious preference for Congressman Doolittle.

Demand is hereby made that you inform the representatives of your department to immediately place all letters, written memorandum, electronic messages, copies of expense reports, copies of telephone bills, etc. related to: (1) the making of this video by President Bush, (2) communications with Congressman Doolittle and (3) the Adventology hospital investigation on “*litigation hold*”. Litigation is forthcoming and demand is made upon you to ensure that these records are safely archived.

I direct you to Fed. R. Civ. Proc. Rules 26(b)(1) and 34(a) for guidance, should you need any. All future e-mails, letters, electronic documents and files should be placed on “*litigation hold*”. See Zubulake v. USB Warburg, LLC, 220 F.R. D. 212, 218 (S.D.N.Y. 2003). As a courtesy to you I shall place a copy of this letter on my public interest web-site.

This letter is sent to you pursuant to my duties as a private attorney general as the United States is presently without an Attorney General.
